What are the major differences between Ayurveda, Allopathy, Homeopathy and Electrohomeopathy systems of medicine?

The major aim of all the systems of medicine is to cure the diseased. However, their motto is identical but the way of approach is different and it completely depends on their principles. For example if we take the Malaria then we find **3 major differences** in Ayurveda, Allopathy, Homeopathy and Electrohomeopathy systems of medicine.

- I. **Diagnosis** of Malaria disease.
- II. **Method of Malaria Drugs Preparation.**
- III. **Mode of Drug administration and Efficacy.**

Let us see the differences in 4 systems of medicine in detail:

I. **Diagnosis of Malaria disease.**

Ayurveda: The cause of the malaria disease was not diagnosed, so it is considered as an intermittent fever.

Allopathy: The cause of the malaria has diagnosed as Plasmodium parasite and till now 5 types of malaria are identified.

Homeopathy: The exact cause of malaria was not diagnosed. However, as per its principle of "Similia Similibus Curantur" it was considered as intermittent fever. Which produces similar symptoms of malaria when Cinchona plant was given to a healthy person.

Electrohomeopathy: The exact cause of malaria was not diagnosed. However, as per its principle of "Complexa Complexis Curantur" a complex disease needs complex medicine and the disease is caused by the external infection or internal imbalance.

II. **Method of Malaria Drugs Preparation.**

Ayurveda: Malaria is treated with 5 medicinal plants (combine or separately). There is no definite method of drug preparation.

Allopathy: All 5 types of Malaria has complete treatment with ~15 drugs. These drugs are either extracted from naturally available medicinal plants (eg. Cinchona) by the method of natural product extraction using alcohol as solvent or synthesised from chemicals.

Homeopathy: Malaria is treated with only one/two Cinchona plant.

Cinchona plant is extracted by natural product extraction method using Alcohol (chemical name Ethanol) as solvent.

Electrohomeopathy: All 5 types of Malaria is treated with a drug known as FEBRIFUGO which is prepared from 10 medicinal plants (including Cinchona) extraction. The drug Febrifugo is prepared by a well known method of natural product extraction of 10 medicinal plants (including cinchona) known as COHOBATION using 100% water (distilled water) at 35 degree celsius. These 10 medicinal plant extracts (Spagyric Essence) has all types of 15 drugs (which are used in allopathy) and other related drugs which is capable to treat all 5 or more types of malaria disease.

III. **Mode of Drug administration and Efficacy.**

Ayurveda: There is no specific plant or chemical component identified for the treatment of Malaria.

Allopathy: Specific drugs are identified but there is no single drug to treat all 5 types of malaria.

Homeopathy: Specific plant Cinchona discovered but all 5 types are treated with Cinchona plant.

Electrohomeopathy: It treats all 5 types of malaria and it has specific drugs including Cinchona.
